Science—Materials

- Objects are made from materials. E.g. metal, wood, fabric.
- Objects can be grouped based on the materials they are made from.
- Every material has different properties. For example, wood is hard.

A bench is an object and is made from wood.



A bottle is an object and this is made from plastic



A jumper is an object and it is made from fabric



A window is an object and it is made from glass.
