Christians believe that God is made up of 3 things called a Trinity; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Christians believe that the Father sends his Son to save people. The Son spreads the word of the Holy Spirit to his followers.

Christians believe that the Holy Spirit is God's power working in the world and in their lives.

Christians try to understand God by using symbols, songs, stories, poems and art.


The gospel called 'The Baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist' tells the story of when Jesus was baptised in the River Jordan.

When he came out of the water, they saw the Holy Spirit of God. This is why many Christians choose to be baptised.

| Trinity | The Trinity is God in 3 different forms. The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. |
| Holy Spirit | The presence of God in Christian's lives. |
| gospel | Gospels are stories in the bible which tell about the life and teachings of Jesus. |
| baptism | A baptism is a special event which welcomes people into Christianity. This usually involves cleaning the head with water. |
| worship | To worship is to show respect to someone or something. Christians can worship through prayer, singing and kind actions towards others. |
| prayer | Words that are spoken to God to show thanks, hope or to ask for advice. |
