What do Christians learn from the Creation Story?

(This unit explores where Creation fits in the 'big story' of Christianity)



RE knowledge

Christians believe that God created the world and everything that lives there. God the Creator cares for the creation, including human beings.

Christians have rituals and routines because they believe God is the Creator.

As human beings are part of God's good **creation**, they do best when they listen to God.

The Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him — he keeps his relationship with them, gives them guidelines on good ways to live (such as **The Ten Commandments**).
