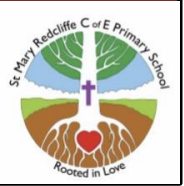

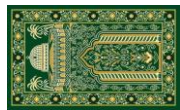
## Term 1: What makes some places sacred?

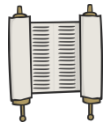

### RE Vocabulary

Word	Definition
<b>Church</b> 	A <b>sacred</b> building where Christians meet to pray
<b>Mosque</b> 	A <b>sacred</b> building where Muslims meet to pray
<b>Pray</b> 	To talk to God
<b>Sacred</b>	A holy place or object that has a special connection with God
<b>Synagogue</b> 	A <b>sacred</b> building where Jews meet to pray
